QUESTION 1

In what ways did the British-Order-in-Council of June 1903 bring about many changes in the lives of the Swazi?

QUESTION 2

“The concession issue was still a major problem for the Swazi even after the British take over in 1903.” Discuss this statement showing how far this problem was not solved by the British take over.

QUESTION 3

Discuss the attitude of Britain towards economically developing Swaziland before World War II. Discuss the agrarian policy and any four development schemes and industries opened up in Swaziland after the war.

QUESTION 4

Discuss four (4) examples of industrial actions staged by workers in Swaziland before the introduction of trade unions in the country in the 1960s.

QUESTION 5

Analyse the political conditions in Swaziland which led King Sobhuza II to issue the 1973 Proclamation. State the reaction of the Swazi to this proclamation.
