QUESTION 1

Examine the various reasons which made the Dlamini to move out of Delagoa Bay; then explain the historical context which gave birth to the Dlamini praise name "*Wena lowacedza Lubombo ngekuhlehetela!*" ("You who wandered the Lubombo Ranges in haste!")

QUESTION 2

Trace the events that transpired during Sobhuza I's forced migration from the Pongola Valley to Dlodlomo.

QUESTION 3

Show how Sobhuza I conquered the Sotho at Dlodlomo; the Maseko of Mgazi and the Magagula under Mnjoli up to the death of Dvokolwako.

QUESTION 4

Compare and contrast the concession granting exercise carried out by Mswati II and Mbandzeni. Give three reasons to justify their actions.

QUESTION 5

Give the background events which led to Lord Selborne's 1907 Land Partition Proclamation and discuss two terms of this proclamation.
