**Choose and answer two (2) questions from the following. Each question is worth 25 marks.**

**QUESTION 1**

Analyse four reasons discussed by Dr J.S.M.Matsebula on why Zwide wanted to attack the Ngwane and kill King Sobhuza I during their stay at the Pongola area. Discuss two attempts made by the King to try and appease Zwide.

**QUESTION 2**

Trace the events that transpired during King Sobhuza I's forced migration from Shiselweni to Dlomodlomo.

**QUESTION 3**

Analyse King Sobhuza I's pattern of territorial conquest from the time Zwide stopped pursuing him at Dlomodlomo up to the conquest of the Magagula of Mnjoli.

**QUESTION 4**

Explain how King Mswati I continued the territorial expansion started by his father and explain two strategies he used to protect the already conquered territory.

**QUESTION 5**

Give the background events which led to Lord Selborne's 1907 Land Partition Proclamation and discuss two effects of this proclamation on the Swazi.
