QUESTION 2

"The three strategies of conquest used by King Sobhuza I during his nation building process showed that he did not want to appear aggressive towards other groups." Discuss this assertion by using any three examples of groups he dealt with at this time.

QUESTION 3

Show how the early years of King Mswati II's reign were marred by internal revolts by discussing any three succession disputes he had to deal with.

QUESTION 4

Using any three examples, describe how King Mswati II incorporated some clans through intervention rather than offensive military invasion.

QUESTION 5

Give the background events which led to Lord Selborne's 1907 Land Partition Proclamation and discuss two effects of this proclamation on the Swazi.
